### The Side Saddle Association - SHOW POINTS TROPHIES

Competitors must declare they wish to take part in the Points Trophies Competitions, at the time of Entry, by ticking the relevant Boxes on the Entry Form for the relevant Trophies. <u>Those Competitors will be given a Points Card in their Competitor Envelope. Points</u> <u>Cards MUST BE completed and sent to the NSSSG Show Office by 10<sup>th</sup> AUGUST 2018</u>... with all accompanying paperwork, letters etc.

In all classes (EXCEPT Area Team Competitions, Pairs, Family Horse/Pony and Fancy Dress) Competitors may claim points: 10 for 1<sup>st</sup>, 9 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 8 for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 7 for 4<sup>th</sup>, 6 for 5<sup>th</sup> and 5 for 6<sup>th</sup> and 4 for **completing** the Class, regardless of placing. In the case of a tie, the Winner is the competitor with the greatest number of first places. In case of a further tie, the Winner is the competitor who has **completed** the most Classes and in case of a further tie, the Trophy shall be held for equal periods of time by each of the tied Competitors. Winners will be notified and Trophies sent to them after the Show; results will be published in the SSA Newsletter and Winners invited to be formally presented with their Trophy at the next SSA AGM.

**Black Fen Royalist Bowl** (*Class 801*), donated by **The Late Mrs J Bredin**, will be awarded to the Adult Member winning the most points at this year's Show.

In order to compete at the CHAPS (UK) Championship Show the horse must be registered and the owner/rider must become a showing member, prior to the CHAPS Championship Show commencing. Following wildcard qualification at the National Side Saddle Show, competitors are required to become VHS Members and to register their horse/pony in order to go forward to compete at the Supreme Final when they must compete riding side saddle.

# FRIDAY-DRESSAGE

Unless otherwise stated, Dressage and Freestyle to Music Classes will be run under BD rules UNDER NSSSG RULES DRESSAGE CLASS RIDER TURNOUT IS AS FOR EQUITATION CLASS

#### TURNOUT & ADULTS NOT WEARING SAFETY HATS DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK Presentations to Dressage Class Trophy Winners, Special Dressage Awards & Area Dressage Teams Trophies & place rosettes will be on Friday evening

**PLEASE NOTE:** In accordance with NSSSG rules, where the Arena construction makes it impossible for Competitors to ride round the outside, before the judge's signal to enter is sounded, Competitors may ride inside the Arena. Where a 40m x 20m Arena has been created within a 60m x 20m Arena, Competitors are permitted to ride in the entire Arena. Competitors may enter at A from inside or outside the Arena.

**1. Times** - See General Show Rules. Every effort will be made to accommodate Competitors' requests for which pony/horse is ridden first, **provided** requests are made when entering.

**2.** Bridles, etc. - BD Rules concerning bitting and saddlery, with the exception that Double or Pelham bridles are permitted in the Freestyle to Music Classes. Walk & Trot, Preliminary and Novice tests may only be ridden in Snaffle bridles. (Other tests may be ridden in a Snaffle or Double Bridle). For the Jumping Phase of the Dressage with Jumping classes, Standing Martingales and Market Harboroughs are not permitted. No protection of the horses' legs is permitted in any NSSSG/BD Dressage Test.

**3. Scoring** - In accordance with BD competitions, the total marks for a test will be converted into a percentage and the highest percentage score will be the Winner. In the event of equality of marks/percentages, the horse/pony with the higher collective marks shall take the higher placing. If the collective marks are also equal, the place will be shared. However, in Pick a Test classes, if the collective marks are equal, the horse/pony having done the higherlevel test will be the winner. For Dressage with Jumping Classes, see Note 10.

**4. Commanded Tests** - Dressage tests may be commanded (except for the Dressage to Music, Rococo and Caro Cripps). **Commanders must be appropriately dressed, wearing a hat.** 

**5. BD Dressage Sheets** - Test sheets may be obtained from the British Dressage Office, Telephone 02476 698830 or www.britishdressage.co.uk

**6. Score Sheets** for the RDA/SSA Intro Test can be obtained by sending an SAE to the NSSSG Show Office or from the Show Website <u>www.nationalsidesaddleshow.co.uk</u>

**7. Second Entries** for rides in dressage classes will be accepted provided the class is not full. A waiting list will be kept, giving priority to first rides in the event of cancellations or withdrawals. Competitors with a wait-listed second entry may declare which horse is to be ridden to the NSSSG Show Office **NO LATER** than 12 noon on the Monday of the week preceding the Show.

8. Freestyle to Music Competitors are required to hand in their music to the Show Office or Commentary Box at least 2 hours before the start of the Class (AND COLLECT AFTERWARDS). Music must be marked with the Competitor's Name, Number and Class Number.

**9. Music Licences** are **not required** at Addington Manor Equestrian Centre because they hold their own Performing Rights Licence.

#### 10. Dressage with Jumping Rules

a) To be judged in accordance with BD rules for the Dressage phase and BS Rules for the jumping phase, except that a fall of horse or rider or a 3rd disobedience incurs elimination.

b) Competitors must wear a hat to current Safety Standard or above for the Jumping Phase.

c) Jumping will incur penalties; 1<sup>st</sup> disobedience - 4 penalties, 2<sup>nd</sup> - 8, 3<sup>rd</sup> - Elimination. Knocking down an obstacle will incur 4 penalties. Penalties will be deducted from the Dressage good marks.

d) To avoid an undue influence from the Dressage phase, a multiplying factor will be applied.

e) The Winner shall be the competitor with the highest number of good marks. In the event of a tie the dressage score takes precedence followed by the fastest jumping time. If the marks are still equal the horse/pony with the higher collective marks shall take the higher place and if still equal the horse/pony having done the higher level test will be the winner.

1. Open to all horses/ponies, regardless of BD points. Riders may be any age.

2. Lead Rein permitted (unplaced LR Competitors will receive a Rosette) and must ride the RDA/SSA Test.

(Lead Rein Competitors must state they are Lead Rein for the duration of the Show when entering.

3. Non Lead Rein Competitors must ride the BD Intro Test.

4. Horses/Ponies may only compete once.

5. The same horse/pony/rider combination may not compete in classes 2 to 9 inclusive.

6. The highest percentage score regardless of the test ridden will be the winner. In the event of equality see Dressage Rules.

The Highest placed Lead Rein and Highest placed Off the Lead Rein receive Special Rosettes & Awards, donated by Miss P Doran and Ms H Staples.

#### Class 2 Native Breed Dressage

Entry Fee: £16.00 (Including the £1 non-refundable Judge's Fee charged per Competitor entered) BD Preliminary Test No. 14 (2006) Arena 20m x 40m Judge: Miss P Doran, Kent Open to horses/ponies of Mountain and Moorland type, with less than 50 BD points, riders any age.

The Winner receives the Waverhead Black Magic Memorial Trophy, donated by The Brocklebank Fell Pony Stud.

### Class 3 (Sections A&B) The SSA Area 19 Novice Dressage

Entry Fee: £16.00 (Including the £1 non-refundable Judge's Fee charged per Competitor entered) Section 3A BD Prelim Test No. 14 (2016)

Section 3B BD Novice Test No 27 (2007)

Arena 20m x 40m

Judge: Mrs Y Huber, Sussex 1. Open to all horses/ponies, regardless of BD points. Riders may be any age.

2. Competitors may ride either of the tests listed but must state which on entry form.

3. Horses/Ponies may only compete once.

4. The highest percentage score regardless of the test ridden will be the winner. In the event of equality, see Dressage Rules

The Winner receives the Sue Brenton Memorial Trophy, donated by Area 8. The Highest Placed Junior receives the Executive Jet Trophy (Class 501) donated by The Senior Family.

#### Class 4 Restricted Dressage

The Highest Placed Horse/Pony with less than 50 BD points at time of entry receives the Newark Cup (Class 502). The Highest Placed Junior receives the Malvern Cup (Class 503). The Highest Placed Horse/Pony, ridden by an Adult which has not been placed 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in affiliated dressage, with less than 20 BD points at time of entry or been placed 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in a dressage class at a previous National Side Saddle Show receives the Kim Reed Cup (Class 504), donated by Kim Reed.

8. Riding times will be given - See General Show Rules.





16. Competitors' Riding Style will be side saddle except where stated otherwise in Class rules.

**17. Competitors' Riding Times** will be allocated for Classes 1 - 16 & 50 - 60, which must be adhered to or risk elimination. Times may be obtained from The NSSSG Show Office on 28th July, 2018 between 1.00 & 5.00pm, preferably by email, the Show Website: <u>www.nationalsidesaddleshow.co.uk</u> and will be displayed at the Show Office. Competitors are responsible for presenting themselves **at least** 15 minutes prior to their allocated time. Competitors may be invited to ride before their allocated time but may elect to wait until their designated time. Classes will not be held up for missing Competitors.

**18.** Dogs must be kept on leads at all times, and are not allowed in Competition or Public Areas, Main Building, Cafeteria or Stable Barn, unless special permission has been obtained from the Show Office. Dogs who bark continuously are not welcomed and you may be asked to remove them. Please "Pooper Scoop"!

19. Dressage Test Callers/Grooms must be smartly and appropriately dressed and wearing a suitable hat.

20. Electric Hook Up must be booked in advance with AMEC using the Stable Booking form. See Note 50.

**21. Emergency Access** must be available at all times and Vehicles parked and tents erected appropriately to reduce the risk of fire and allow emergency access - you will be asked to move if parked unsafely.

**22. Emergencies** requiring assistance at any time should refer to the "On the Showground Emergency Contact Number" in the Schedule, Catalogue and the Show Office Notice Board.

**23.** Entries close on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2017 and will only be accepted "On Line" or on the Official Entry Form. Entries sent by post requiring a delivery signature, telephone, e-mail will NOT be accepted. Payment in full must accompany all entries. Anyone requiring a receipt should send an SAE marked 'Receipt'. Entries received after entries close, will incur a Late Entry Charge of £5.00 per class. See Late Entries.

24. Entry Fees are stated alongside each class. Over payments of under £5.00 will be donated to Show funds. Over payments of more than £5.00 will be refunded. All underpayments will be claimed by the Show. Should classes be cancelled, due to lack of entries, Entry Fees will be refunded.

25. Entry Forms may only be used for a single combination of horse/pony and rider. Additional Entry Forms are available from the Show Website. Office or a photocopy of the Entry Form may be used. Competitors must declare their eligibility for Specials Awards, Trophies, etc., at the time of entering.

**26.** Entry Refunds, less a £10 administration fee, will only be given, under exceptional circumstances.

27. Exercising in ANY ARENA is not permitted on Thursday and then only as shown on the Timetable.

28. Falls of Horse/Pony or Rider in any class will result in elimination and the rider must leave the ring dismounted. It is strongly recommended medical advice be sought before competing in other classes. Judges & Stewards must report all falls, during Judging or at any other time, to the Show Office.

29. Farrier services are by private arrangement only. There will be no "On Call" Farrier.

**30.** Fires in the open are not permitted anywhere at Addington Equestrian Centre.

\*\* 31. Generators must be used with consideration and personal ones be turned off between 11pm and 7am. The Addington Generators will be running all night to supply Hook-Up to those who have paid for it and lights, as required for H&S. If the noise is likely to disturb you, please park away from them.

32. Grooms will only be permitted to enter competing rings at the request of the Judge(s) and must be smartly and appropriately dressed, wearing a suitable hat.

33. Health and Safety (H&S) requires the NSSSG's commitment to fulfilling its legal obligations under the current H&S at Work and associated legislation. Reasonable precautions will be taken by the NSSSG to ensure the H&S of persons present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent any accidents occurring and must obey the Show Organisers and Officials. Any H&S issues should be addressed to the Show Office where the H&S Policy Statement is available.

34. Horses/Ponies considered to be dangerous or unruly may, at the NSSSG's discretion, be asked to leave the Showground and at Judges' discretion, be asked to leave Judging Arenas.

35. Horse walks to Arenas are to be used at all times and failure to do so risks elimination.

36. Insurance, Third Party Liability, should be arranged by Competitors for themselves and their horses. The NSSSG holds Public Liability Insurance.

37. Insurance Liability Disclaimer: AMEC, the NSSSG, the SSA, and their Officials cannot be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to persons, animals or property, however caused. 38. Judges' Decisions are final.

39. Late Entries cannot be accepted for Classes when "Riding Times" are given, unless qualification achieved after entries close, and then must be received by 5.00pm on the Thursday of the Show. For all other classes, if not full, late entries may be accepted, provided the correct documentation is presented at the time of entry, at the NSSSG's discretion. Late entries will incur a surcharge of £5.00 per class, unless for classes requiring qualification, provided qualified after the entries closed. Transferring entries from one class to another or change of horse/ rider will incur a £5.00 surcharge per change.

40. Lead Rein Competitors must be Lead Rein Competitors for the duration of the Show and may only enter the specified classes. The Lead Rein must be affixed to the Noseband, the reins must go direct from the bit to the rider's hand and handlers must be aged 16 or over at the time of the Show.

41. Objections must be made in writing to the Show Office within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the relevant class, or the posting of the Scores. A fee of £35.00 shall accompany any objection and will be returned if the objection is upheld. Only SSA Members may lodge objections in Classes run under SSA rules. 42. Overseas Competitors

i. Members may compete in Equitation Championship classes at all levels, without Qualifying Points, in the Overseas Section, for place rosettes only. Overseas SSA Members who have sufficient Qualifying Points, may compete in both the Qualified and the Overseas Sections but are only required to enter the Qualified Section, Overseas Members are not eligible for any of the Equitation Championship Titles or Awards without gaining the appropriate gualifying points. See the current SSA Members' Handbook.

ii. Dress for Members competing in Equitation and Equitation Jumping classes is in accordance with the current SSA Members' Handbook. Traditional habits may be worn in other classes, depending on class rules.

43. Photographers may only enter Arenas during classes and/or prize giving if they are appointed as the Official Photographers or are wearing a Press Pass, available from the Show Office. Only the NSSSG's Official Photographers may sell photographs at the Show.

44. Polo Shirts ordered in advance will be available for collection from the Show Office. They can also be ordered at the Show for delivery after the Show.

45. Presentations should be attended out of courtesy to Sponsors but if unable to attend because riding in other classes, please inform the NSSSG Show Office. Appropriate dress is appreciated.

46. Prize Money will be awarded as stated but the NSSSG reserves the right to withhold prize money and awards if Classes are amalgamated or cancelled. All prize money must be collected at the show - failure to do so will result in forfeiture. Any uncollected prize money will be put towards future Shows' expenses.

**47. Refreshments** will be available, at the publicised times from the Cafeteria which sells Hot and Cold meals. Judges, Sponsors, Officials, Stewards, Visitors and Trade Stand holders are invited to partake of light refreshments at the "Meet & Greet" Reception Area adjacent to the NSSSG Show Office.

**48.** Saddles, Tack & Equipment rules are in accordance with individual class requirements. Running, draw, check or balancing reins are prohibited at all times. Lunging is permitted, but only in appropriate areas. Side reins may only be used if the horse is being lunged without a rider.

49. Smoking - is strictly forbidden within the Stables and Permanent Buildings.

#### 50. Stabling & Horse Box Park Rules

**i. Stabling** must be booked in advance with AMEC using the Stabling Booking form available from, <u>www.addingtonmanor.co.uk</u>, *Events, click on The National Show in the Diary, then the Stabling Form.* 

ii. Alterations to Stabling booked must be notified to AMEC one week in advance; changing stables is only permitted by arrangement with the AMEC Stable Manager during the Show. Arriving Competitors with Stables booked must report to the AMEC Stable Manager. Competitors may not arrive after 10pm.
 iii. Barbecues are not permitted in the horsebox park.

**iv. Bedding** is a "Deep Litter" system and Stables will be adequately pre-bedded with Straw/Shavings mix. Additional bedding can be purchased from the AMEC Stable Manager.

v. Fire Extinguishers should be carried in all Horseboxes.

vi. Haylage will be available for purchase IN ADVANCE. Details on the AMEC Stable Booking form.

vii. Horses/ponies may only be led/ridden at a walk in the stable and lorry park areas.

viii. Washing of tack/boots in the Lavatories/Showers and horses within the immediate vicinity of the Stables is not permitted.

51. Stallions are required to wear a blue ribbon in their tail whenever they are not in their stable/horsebox.

**52. Timetable** alterations/updates will be included in Competitors' Envelopes and posted in the Show Office. No class will commence before the published time. Every effort will be made to adhere to the Timetable.

**53. Turnout Areas** may not be created anywhere on the Showground.

**54. Trade Stands** space must be booked in advance, with the NSSSG, and will be on the Lawn adjacent to the Arenas. Non-Trade stand holders may not sell goods, or fit or repair saddles for remuneration, within the lorry park, car park or other areas of The Showground.

**55. Trophies** are Perpetual Challenge Trophies, unless otherwise stated, and belong to the SSA. They are presented on the understanding they are returned clean and engraved 1 month prior to the next year's Show or as instructed by letter and Trophy Holders will advise the SSA Trophy Steward of any change of address. Trophies may only be taken home by SSA UK Members.

**56. Vaccination Certificates** are not required by AMEC, however, The NSSSG recommends all horses /ponies should have a current, valid anti-equine influenza vaccination certificate.

**57**. **Veterinary Services** will be available from **Buckingham Equine Vets** on call via the NSSSG Show Office or direct on 01908 560789. Competitors are responsible for paying for any treatment given directly to the Veterinary Surgeon, at the end of treatment, before they leave.


