## The National Side Saddle Show *The Side Saddle Association* INTER-AREA TEAM COMPETITION RULES (updated November 2016, November 2020) Team Entries £9.00 per Team ALL TROPHIES AND PLACE ROSETTES TO BE COLLECTED FROM THE SHOW OFFICE

THE AREA TEAM COMPETITIONS are open to Area Teams drawn from competitors, belonging to their own areas, as shown in the register of members, at the time of declaration.

THE AREA TEAM DRESSAGE COMPETITION is open to any number of Area Teams, each consisting of three of four horses or ponies competing in the Dressage and Dressage to Music classes. The three competitors with the highest percentage score in each team to count. The team achieving the highest total of percentage scores is the winner. In the event of a tie, the team with the highest number of  $1^{st}/2^{nd}/3^{rd}$  placings shall be the winner.

TWO horses or ponies in a team may be drawn from the same class. No horse or pony or rider may compete more than once in a single team but a rider may compete in another team on another horse or pony.

Team riders and horses or ponies shall be declared to the Show Secretary not later than 8.30 am on the Friday of the Show.

The Winning Area's Chairman receives the KEAR-COLWELL BOWL donated by Mrs V Kear-Colwell. Rosettes will be awarded to the first three teams. THE TROPHY AND ROSETTES MUST BE COLLECTED FROM THE SHOW OFFICE.

**THE AREA TEAM EQUITATION COMPETITION** is open to up to three teams from each Area each consisting of three or four competitors in the Adult Open, Adult Intermediate, Adult Novice, Junior Open and Junior Novice *(The Cygnet Championship is not included because there is no qualification required)*. The three competitors with the highest percentage score in each team to count. The team achieving the highest total of percentage scores is the winner. In the event of a tie, the team with the highest number of  $1^{st}/2^{nd}/3^{rd}$  placings shall be the winner. If there is still a tie, the team with the highest placed Adult Open/Junior Open/Adult Intermediate Adult Novice/Junior Novice shall be the winner.

TWO team members may be competitors in the same Equitation Class. No competitor may compete as a member of more than one team.

Names of Teams and Team members must be declared to the Show Secretary no later than 7.00 pm on the Friday of the Show.

The Winning Area's Chairman receives the TREASURER'S BOWL donated by The Late R N James Esq. Rosettes will be awarded to the first three teams. THE TROPHY AND ROSETTES AND MUST BE COLLECTED FROM THE SHOW OFFICE.

THE AREA TEAM EQUITATION JUMPING COMPETITION is open to up to three teams from each Area each consisting of three or four competitors. The three competitors with the highest percentage score in each team to count. The team achieving the highest total of percentage scores is the winner. In the event of a tie, the team with the highest number of  $1^{st}/2^{nd}/3^{rd}$  placings shall be the winner. If there is still a tie, the team with the highest placed Adult Open/Junior Open/Adult Intermediate Adult Novice/Junior Novice shall be the winner.

TWO team members may be competitors in the same Equitation Jumping Class. No competitor may compete as a member of more than one team.

Names of Teams and Team members must be declared to the Show Secretary no later than 7.00 pm on the Friday of the Show.

The Winning Area's Chairman receives the ELEGANT AIRS TROPHY donated by SSA Area 12. Rosettes will be awarded to the first three teams. THE TROPHY AND ROSETTES AND MUST BE COLLECTED FROM THE SHOW OFFICE.

THE AREA TEAM SHOW JUMPING RELAY is open to any number of Area Teams each consisting of three horses or ponies and is run under BS rules.

No horse or pony or rider may compete more than once in a single team, but a rider may ride in another team on a different horse or pony. The Competition shall take the form of a relay competition. The winning team is that with the least number of faults in the fastest time.

Team riders and horses or ponies shall be declared to the Show Secretary not later than 10.00 am on the Sunday of the Show. The Winning Area's Chairman receives the HUTTON + ROSTRON ARMADA DISH. *Rosettes awarded to all competitors at the Mounted Presentation after the Relay.*
